

Household Hazardous Waste Reuse Program

What is a Household Hazardous Waste Reuse Program?

When the Prairieland Household Hazardous Waste Collection program has good, useable products which come into a collection, they place them on the shelves of the “Reuse Room”, label them and make them accessible for people who need these products to take them home and use them up.

What types of “stuff” is available?

There is always a good supply of aerosol, latex and oil base paint. There is also paint thinner, wood preservative, caulk, furniture polish and various other supplies. The items are always changing as it comes in and goes out.

Is there a charge for this program?

There is no charge and you can come for products as often as you like.

Do you have to bring something to exchange?

No. You can just come to get products from this program. You do not have to bring anything.

When is the “Reuse Room” open?

The Reuse Room is open during the regular hours of a household hazardous waste collection held in Truman at the Compost Facility site. The regular hours are: May through September, each Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Where is the Reuse Room located?

The Reuse Room is part of the Household Hazardous Waste Facility located near the entrance of the Prairieland Compost Facility. The Prairieland Compost Facility is located in the Northeast corner of the town of Truman, MN.
