

FARIBAULT COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
EMERGENCY MEETING
OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS
JUNE 26, 2018

The Faribault County Board of Commissioners met in emergency session at the Courthouse in the City of Blue Earth at 8:00 a.m. on June 26, 2018. The following members were present: Bill Groskreutz, Tom Loveall, John Roper, Tom Warmka, and Greg Young Commissioners. Sheriff Mike Gormley, Deputy Sheriff Scott Adams, and County Auditor/Treasurer/Coordinator John Thompson also attended.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Greg Young.

The Auditor stated the reason for the meeting was pursuant to Minnesota Statute 13D.04 Subdivision 3.

Sheriff Gormley and Chief Deputy Adams discussed the situation. The board will need to pass a resolution declaring a state of emergency to be eligible for possible state and/or federal aid. There is a possibility of funding of some kind for private property. Residents will need to contact the county assessor's office to state possible damages to their property. Road authorities, drainage systems, and other infrastructure will be reporting possible damages in the next few days to the sheriff's department/emergency management office. This is the first step in a longer process to explore funding possibilities from federal and state agencies.

Warmka/Loveall motion carried unanimously to approve Resolution 18-CB-22 declaring Faribault County in a state of emergency. Commissioners Groskreutz, Loveall, Roper, Warmka, and Young voted yes.

RESOLUTION
Declaring a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, the June rain impacted the population of Faribault County and its cities; and

WHEREAS, the event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS, the Faribault County Department of Emergency Management requests the Faribault County Board of Commissioners to declare Faribault County in a state of emergency for the June rain event of 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Faribault County Board of Commissioners declares Faribault County in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the rain event of June 2018.
